



How to Play the Action for Nature Garden Race game.

You will need.

- Colour printer.
- Glue or Cello tape.
- Match Sticks.
- Blue Tack
- Paper and Card.

Print out the game board, question cards and playing pieces.

Cut out the playing pieces and die and glue to thin card.

Push a pencil through the centre of the die and fold the playing pieces so that they will stand up.

Cut out the question cards. These can be glued to thin card.

Cut out the Garden Notice boards and glue them to thin card. Stick a match stick to the back of the card to make a central post for each notice board and then stick on to the game board at the appropriate square with a blob of blue tack.

You may like to stick the game board to a sheet of cardboard.

Each player picks a playing piece to use and places it on the door mat of the house.

The question cards are shuffled and placed face down on the table.

The race is to the statue in the middle of the garden following the numbered track.

Spin the die for who goes first. Highest goes first.

That player then spins the die for the number of squares his counter moves.

The person to the left takes a card from the deck and reads out the question with the same number as that the player rolled. If the player gets the answer right he stays where he is if not he moves back one square.

The player then has to carry out any instructions written on the Garden Notice board if one is present on his square.

The Pond must be cleared in one go. If a move will not clear the pond the player stays on square 38.

The Frog is the only player who ignores the pond and swims across.

It is now the turn of the next player to spin the die and the process is repeated.
