


















Plants and Animals of Trafford

No 5 Common Garden Birds

<p>Blackbird</p>		<p>Nests. In trees and dense bushes building nest from moss twigs and mud. Eats. Worms berries and insects. Female . is similar size but a mottled brown</p>
<p>Robin</p>		<p>Nests. Well hidden in Ivy or near base of tree. Domed of leaves and lined with roots and hairs. Eats. Insects and small seeds</p>
<p>Wren</p>		<p>Nests. Thick vegetation in brambles or Ivy. Eats. Insects.</p>
<p>Blue Tit</p>		<p>Nests. Holes in Trees and Walls Eats. Seed and insects</p>
<p>House Sparrow</p>		<p>Nests. Thick bush or ivy or hole in buildings in a small colony. Eats. grain and insects</p>

Great Tit		<p>Nests. Hole in Tree or Wall Eats. Seeds and insects</p>
Coal Tit		<p>Nests. Holes in Trees Eats. Seeds and Insects.</p>
Dunnock or Hedge Sparrow		<p>Nests. Deep inside a bush from twigs, moss and leaves. Eats. Insects , Small seeds.</p>
Wood Pigeon		<p>Nests. In thick vegetation. Eats. Leaves and seeds.</p>
Bull Finch		<p>Nests. Dense bush or brambles cup of twigs lined with roots. Eats. Seeds and tree buds especially Fruit trees.</p>
Collard Dove		<p>Nests. In building or Tree flimsy sticks. Eats. Leaves and seeds.</p>
Chaffinch		<p>Nests. Tree bush cup of grass. Eats. Seeds insects</p>

Magpie		<p>Nests. Top of tree with domed or detached roof. Twigs lined mud and fine roots. Eats. Seeds, insects and small birds.</p>
Starling		<p>Nests. In hole in tree building cup of grass. Eats. Insects and other invertebrates</p>
Gold Finch		<p>Nests. Thick bush or outer branches of a tree. Grass cup lined with hair or down. Eats. Seeds especially teasel and thistles.</p>
Green finch		<p>Nests. Shrub or low tree cup of moss and twigs. Eats. seeds</p>
Carrion Crow		<p>Nests. Top of tree lined with wool. Eats. Grain, insects, small birds and carrion.</p>
Jackdaw		<p>Nests. In holes in trees or buildings. Lined with twigs and wool. Eats. Insects, Worms, steals sea bird eggs.</p>
Jay		<p>Nests. High in a tree cup of twigs lined with roots Eats. Seeds, insects and nestlings.</p>

<p>Thrush</p>		<p>Nests. In bush or tree in cup shaped nest of grass and mud. Eats. Worms, Snails and Berries</p>
<p>Long Tailed Tit</p>		<p>Travels in extended family groups Nests. In thick vegetation in ball nest of moss feathers and spiderswebs Eats. Small insects</p>
